High Achievement Support Policy

DEFINITION

St. Michael's College Parents and Friends Association exists for the benefit of the College and its students...

St. Michael's College Parents and Friends (P & F) Association is focused on supporting the high achievements of our students. As such the P&F have implemented a policy to assist students as they attend Regional, State or National events representing our college.

Eligibility and Application:

We invite any student that has, through normal college activities, proceeded to represent the college at a higher level of competition, to apply for some funding from the P&F Association Inc.

You will find the "High Achievement Support Application form" under the P&F section of the college website. Please complete this form and submit to the office for review.

Entitlements:

The support that the P&F provides is a tiered approach relative to the level of event as follows:

Regional and State:

- 50% of the Levies
- 50% of the Uniforms
- 50% of the Airfare for student only, and
- \$100 towards Accommodation

Nationals:

- 100% of the Levies
- 100% of the Uniforms
- 50% of the Airfare for student only
- \$200 towards Accommodation, and
- \$100 towards the cost of car hire.

(This is all calculated in the application form)

Approval Process:

The application form is to be reviewed by the college according to the entitlement criteria and at the next P&F general meeting, the application will be presented to the meeting for ratification and inclusion in the minutes.
